


From the Pastors Desk:

Ecclesiastes 3:1 "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens:" NIV

If I asked you to rank the seasons of the year from your favorite to least favorite, how would you rank them? Here is my ranking: 1 – Summer, 2 (and 3, it's a tie) – Fall/Spring, and 4 – Winter.

I love summer; the warmer days, the sun, being outside walking, swimming, or reading, more daylight, and of course I can't forget about ice cream. I'm sad that summer will be coming to an end.

But no matter how I feel, summer will be ending and the fall season will begin. There are a few things about fall I do enjoy, like the changing colors of the leaves, morning walks when it is cooler, and of course football season!

I know all of you have reasons why you like a certain season more than another and even though we have a favorite season, the neat thing is, when we are in a least favorite season, we know that our favorite season will be arriving.

As all of you know, I (and Beth) have gone through and are still in a season of loss. But I also feel we are in a season of growth through loss. And it isn't always easy, but we know that God is with us every step of the way. I believe this season has not only brought us closer to God but to grow more in trusting Him.

To grow takes work; seeds have to set roots and break through the soil to produce fruit. The same goes for all of us in our faith walk. I can only speak for me, but what I'm learning and growing in to is that God has wanted me to grow in trusting Him more. The last 18 months things have happened to test that trust. It was hard, but it allowed me to see how much I really needed to trust God

with my life and what was happening, instead of trusting in myself.

In this chapter of Ecclesiastes, Solomon reminds us that there is a season for everything; we will experience good and not so good; you can read verses 2-8 and see the contrasts.

God acknowledges that we may experience seasons of great abundance or great loss. We can experience great joy or great pain. But the beautiful thing of all of this is: "He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end." Ecclesiastes 3:11

No matter what season you are in; whether it is lack or abundance, good or bad, loss or growth, remember that God is with you. He loves you and everything you experience is meant to grow you closer to Him. Cling tight to Him, whatever your season because there is a time for everything.
