



## FROM THE PASTORS DESK

*Psalm 23: 1-3, "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul..." NIV*

Well, here we are, September 1<sup>st</sup> and heading into the season of fall. For the most part, I will miss the hot and sunny days, but with each season, there is something to look forward to.

As I think about the summer, the heat and humidity were relentless at times and it just drains your energy. When going inside after being out in the heat, we crave refreshment, whether it is sitting with the air conditioning on, sitting in front of a fan, or having a cold glass of water or tea, we all want refreshment. How do we feel after we have that tall glass of ice water, or a day spent in a pool, or just sitting in a cool room? We feel comfortable and relaxed. We may say, "ahh, that's just what I needed."

This physical refreshment reminds me of another kind of refreshment that we also need, a kind of refreshment that we need regularly. Just like needing to recover from the heat of the summer, we need to recover spiritually from the things that accumulate in our lives (work, responsibilities, demands, and even activities).

We all know that Psalm 23 describes God as a shepherd who helps us get the rest we need, leads us beside quiet waters, and refreshes our souls. God makes it possible for us to enjoy the spiritual revival and renewal we all need.

How can we rely on God to refresh our souls? "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing." When God is our shepherd, He is guiding us, protecting us, and giving us what we need. Just like a good shepherd, He makes sure we have what we need to thrive... what's truly important for our well-being. When we trust that God provides for us, a peace settles in our souls and that peace refreshes us from the inside out.



“He makes me lie down in green pastures.” In this busy world, it can be hard to rest. We may take breaks: sit on the couch and watch some TV or a movie or scroll on our phones, but real rest – the kind that makes our soul feel new again – often escapes us. God knows we need rest and He encourages us to lie down in green pastures. “Green pastures” are those times and places of prayer and meditation, experiences enjoying God’s creation, or any other kind of “break” that refreshes our souls.

The second part of the verse says, “He leads me beside quiet waters.” Quiet and still waters are peaceful. When our minds are racing and our spirits are troubled, God offers us His peace, which is much stronger than anything we will ever face. We can enjoy following God to “quiet waters” by focusing on God’s peaceful presence with us.

And, “he refreshes my soul.” This is the result of God being our shepherd. When God refreshes our souls, He sends us the strength we need for what’s ahead in our life. God has unlimited strength, so He can empower us in every way we need strength from Him.

So, just like we find air conditioning and a cold drink to refresh us, we can turn to God when we need to be refreshed spiritually. As we wrap up the summer season, let’s remember that when it was hot and humid and we enjoyed a cold drink to cool us down physically, we also need to seek spiritual refreshment from God as well. He will give us what we need... He will lead us to green pastures, beside quiet waters, and He WILL refresh our souls. Amen.

*Prayer: O God, our Good Shepherd, thank you for knowing exactly what our souls need. Lead us to those quiet places where we can drink deeply of your peace. Help me to recognize and cherish the moments of refreshment which you give to us. Amen.*
