



Matthew 28:1-6 "After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. ² There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. ³ His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. ⁴ The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. ⁵ The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. ⁶ He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay." NIV

Well, we just wrapped up Christmas and New Year's and here we are in Lent. Time is a thief and it seems to fly by faster and faster. On Transfiguration Sunday, I mentioned transfiguration is like the metamorphosis of a butterfly, there is change from the inside out. There are many parables about butterflies and Jesus.

The one I want to share with you is the parable of the butterfly and Easter. For every caterpillar the time comes when the urge to eat and grow subsides and it instinctively begins to form a chrysalis around itself. The chrysalis hardens and you'd think for all the world that the caterpillar is dead.

But one spring morning the life inside the chrysalis begins to squirm, the top cracks open, and a beautifully-formed butterfly emerges. For hours it will stand stretching and drying its wings, moving them slowly up and down. And then, before you know it, the butterfly flies off, effortlessly riding the currents of the air. Somehow, the miracle of the butterfly never loses its fascination for us. Perhaps because the butterfly is a living parable of the promise of resurrection.

On Easter morning the disciples saw Jesus' graveclothes lying on the cold slab still wrapped around His body. Only His body was gone, much like an empty chrysalis deserted by a butterfly who has left to soar free. "He is risen!"

We have all lost a loved one. At time, where our loved one had been so full of life, now their body lays still. When we go to a funeral



home for a viewing, maybe we think about our own mortality. One day we too will die.

What do we Christians say in the face of death? There are many mysteries. But two things we know for sure. First, death is an enemy. But second, and more important, Jesus' resurrection from the grave is God's proof to us that death is not the end. The empty tomb and the Holy Spirit within us testify that Easter morning is God's triumph over death. And ultimately, Jesus promised, God will raise from the dead us who believe in His Son.

Why do Christians gather on Easter morning? To show off their fine clothes? I hope not! Rather we gather to celebrate Jesus' victory over death itself. For since He is our Lord and our Savior, His victory is our victory. In celebrating His resurrection, we celebrate our own assurance of ultimate triumph over death.

Join us this Easter as we celebrate Life!

An Easter prayer: Dear Lord, on this glorious Easter morning, we rejoice in the resurrection of your Son, Jesus Christ. Thank you for the hope and new life that Easter brings. May we live in the light of His victory over death. Amen.



Guatemala Mission Trip






